




Boca Grandeur Terry Seitz travels the world for his furniture business and this time he's in Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina.

The top photo represents the neighborhood of "El Boca," a most charming and colorful neighborhood full of great caricature statues.

The Colon Theatre is listed as the second best or best theatre in the world - for audio purposes as well as grandeur and historical element. It took 20 years to build and it is constructed of marble from several countries. It is over 100 years old and occupies an entire city block.
